



Willow Lakes Fishery Match Rules

KEEPNET RULES:

- Anglers are to supply their own nets (minimum of 2 for carp and 1 for silver at all times)
 - All keepnets must be dry when bought onto site
- At all times of the year keepnets must be laid on the bank on arrival to your peg prior to fishing and can only be put into the water 10 minutes before the match start.
- All landing nets, keepnets and slings must be dipped on arrival when the dip tanks are available for use.
 - No rocks or stones to be put inside keepnets.
- Do not tumble fish down the keepnet when weighing – collapse the net, pull the 2nd or 3rd ring from the bottom through the top of the keepnet.
 - No knotted keepnets.

GENERAL RULES:

- All cars to be parked at the owner's risk – no risk is accepted by "Willow Lakes Fishery" regardless of the cause.
- All anglers must park in the match car park ONLY and no access is permitted to the Caravan Park unless previously arranged with the site owner (Sophie Chilton).
- All safety signs and information signs must be read and accepted prior to entering the fishery.
 - No dogs – except assistance dogs.
 - All litter must go home or in the bins provided.
- Due to water borne disease please take care with hygiene and cover all cuts.
 - All fish are to be returned to the lake they are caught from.
 - Carp and silvers must be kept in separate nets.
 - All fish are to be landed with a landing net (No swinging in)
 - Your boundary is halfway between you and the next angler.
 - No gardening of any kind.
 - No braid or dacron
 - No fish to be handled in towels

HOOK RULES:

- Barbless hooks only
- Maximum of size 10 hook

BAIT RULES:

- No ground bait
 - No hemp
 - No dog or cat meat
 - No nuts
 - No floating baits
- No bait is to enter the water once the match is finished (Please either take it home or dispose of via the bins provided).

- ★ Nets weighing 50lb and under will be weighed in
- ★ Nets weighing between 50lb and 54lb 15oz will be knocked back to 50lb ONLY
- ★ Nets weighing 55lb and over will be disqualified!
